

Working together to meet tailored local objectives and needs



Circle has a long and successful record of working in partnership with smaller organisations including Black and Minority Ethnic Housing Associations (BME) partners and works with many organisations that are approved by Local Authorities as preferred suppliers.

In recent years Circle has also developed affordable housing for other specialist partner organisations such as Housing for Women, the Industrial Dwellings Society and Tamil Community Housing Association.

Partnerships include:

Circle developed all of the social rent affordable housing for the North London Muslim Housing Association (NLMHA) on the RIBA award winning development on Seven Sisters Rd, Finsbury Park, North London. Circle is also currently developing a further 39 homes for NLMHA.

Apna Ghar specialise in housing for people with physical disabilities and from Asian communities. Circle completed two purpose built wheelchair standard flats for Apna Ghar Housing Association

in Haringey. This project had to meet cultural and ethical needs whilst supporting tenants to live independently

In partnership with Barratt Homes, Circle Anglia is developing 37 affordable homes for Spitalfields Housing Association (SHA) in Bromley By Bow
