## Our Support Service



We provide care and support to people with learning disabilities.



Our aim is to enhance the Life Chances of everyone we support. This means helping people to have better lives.



We support people with lots of different needs to live in their own homes.



Some people need a lot of support for most of the day. Some people only need a few hours of support every week.



You will have a support worker who will help you to write a support plan. This will give information about the support you want.



This might include support in your own home, activities, support to go to college or support to go to work.



We respect the rights and wishes of all the people we support.



We have lots of ways for you to tell us what you think about how we support you.

## Who can apply?

18

You need to be over 18 years old.



You also need to have a learning disability, physical disability or another support need which is linked to your disability.
